Description of Company, Supply Base 5 and Forest Management

Description of Company 5.1

SCA is a Swedish based company with more than 4200 employees. Initially the start up was in 1929 as forest owner. At the moment SCA owns 5 sawn mills and 3 pellets productions units in Sweden with a capacity of 300 000 tonnes pellets per year.

SCA is one of Europe's largest producers of forest-based bioenergy, with a total production of about 9 TWh per year.

For the SBP certification the Chain of Custody is set to the external purchase of wood pellets. The site selected for certification is the administrative office at Sundsvall.

Results

Main strengths and weaknesses 7.1

The audit was conducted in an open and positive environment. Company was well prepared for the audit both in knowledge as in manual and management system. No issues were found that could be raised as noncompliance to the requirement of the standard. The comprehensive procedures and record keeping are thought to be more than sufficient for the size and complexity of the company.

Rigour of Supply Base Evaluation 7.2

Not applicable: SCA Energy AB acts as a trader of woody biomass. No storage or processing.

Collection and Communication of Data 7.3

As certificate is not obtained yet, the company has not been provided access to DTS. Nevertheless knowledge on filling the SREG is reviewed and sufficiently demonstrated.

Competency of involved personnel 7.4

For the SBP processes, SCA Energy AB has limited itself to the involvement of view personnel. Competence and expertise is demonstrated in interviews. Although no access to DTS system was given yet, the interviewed personnel demonstrated knowledge of the system and processes to the transfer of claim when starting to trade.
